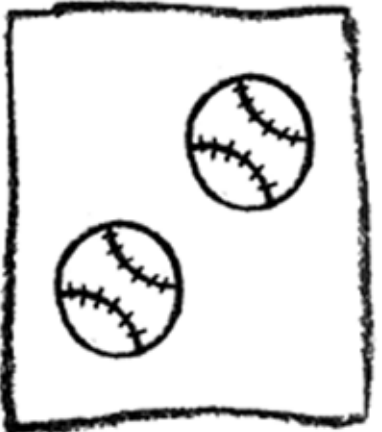

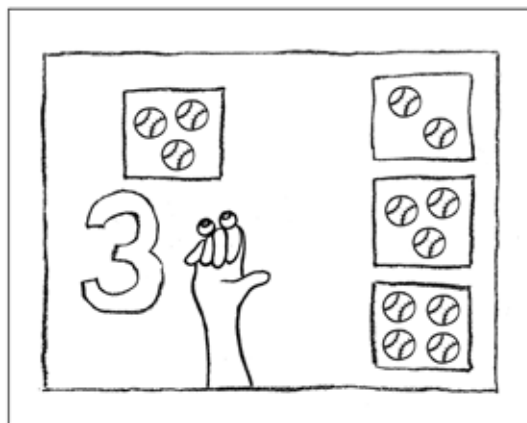
Oobi Numbers

WHAT TO DO

Explain that this is the "Oobi Numbers" game. Point out the box with 3 balls next to Oobi. Ask: **How many balls are in this box?** If necessary, help your child count the balls.

Then point out the boxes with balls along the right side of the page. Ask: **Can you find another box with the SAME number of balls in it?** Tell your child to draw a line to connect the two boxes that have the same number of balls.

Finally, invite your child to color in the page.

LEARNING GOALS

Mathematics: Develop concepts of number and quantity by counting and by comparing more, less, and the same number. Develop the ability to do number operations by counting and by identifying sets.
