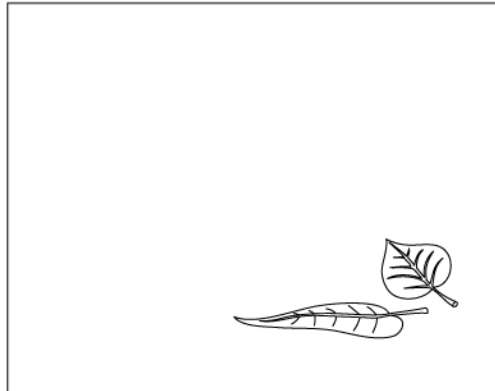

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WHAT TO DO

ALTERNATE PLAY

Find leaves, trace them, and color in the drawings.

FOLLOWING UP

Make the most of this activity by discussing your child's observations about the leaves. Ask questions like, **How are these leaves different from each other? How are they the same? Which one do you like the best?**

LEARNING GOALS

Observing objects in nature, like leaves, is a basic science skill. Identifying characteristics, similarities and differences is an important element of logical thinking.
