


Math fun on your phone to help you feed Ruff's hungry movie crew. You'll need:

- · iPhone with the free Lunch Rush! app from iTunes




# 1 PRINT & CUT

Spread them out, high or low. Across the floor is best if there's room to run!




### 3 Tap

Pick how many people are playing and pick your names.




## 5 PLaY




#### **Tips**

- You can put your game pieces up high or on the floor. You can tape them to the walls or ceiling. Anywhere that your screen can see them.
- Look for the game piece with the number that should replace the "?" on screen. For example, in the question 2 + 5 = ?, look for the "7" game piece and then tap it.




