1 Using toothpicks to connect your marshmallows, build a marshmallow tower.

2 How high did you get your marshmallow tower to go? Measure it with a ruler to find out.

3 What shapes did you use to create a sturdy tower? What could you do to build a higher marshmallow tower? What would happen if you used different-sized marshmallows? How about if you built a wider base or a narrower base? Be sure to predict what you think is going to happen. Then, test your question and send your results to ZOOM.



Are marshmallows good building materials? What other materials can you use to build a tower? Try building a tower using clay and straws or toothpicks and peas.
