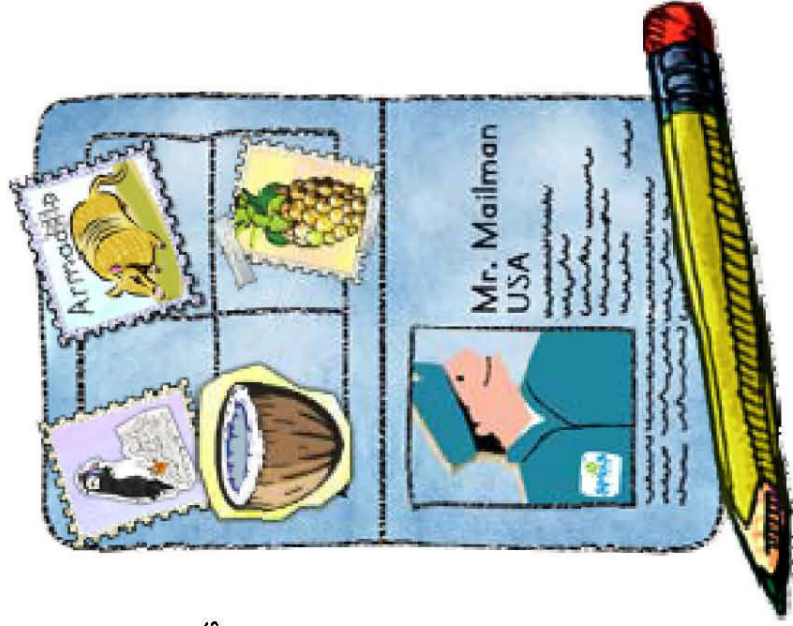
Materials:

This is what you need to make a **Sprout Passport**.

You should be able to find most of these materials around your home.

- Computer Printer
- Plain White Paper
- Colored, or Construction Paper (Larger than the Plain Paper)
- Colored Pencils, Markers, or Crayons
- Glitter, Sequins, Yarn, or Rick-Rack
- Glue, Paste, or a Glue Stick
- Ribbon, Yarn, or String
- Safety Scissors
- Any other decorations that will make your passport one-of-a-kind!

Make Your Own Sprout Passport!

Step 1:

Download and print the Passport Kit.

Step 2:

Draw a picture of yourself and ask a big person for help writing out your name and information on the passport form.

Use crayons, colored pencils, or markers to color in the pictures of places and things from the Kit. You can also use the ones that are already colored. Ask a grown-up for help cutting them out.

Step 3:

Make a stack of a few pieces of the plain paper and fold them in half to make the passport's pages.

Fold a piece of large construction paper in half to make the passport's cover.

Place the stack of folded plain paper inside of the construction paper. Make sure your picture and information is on the first page.



Step 4:

Next ask a grown-up Sprout for help cutting a piece of yarn or ribbon long enough to wrap around the pages of the book to hold it all together. Tie it in a bow on the outside of the folded paper.

Step 5:

Glue or paste the drawing of yourself and the cutout pictures into the blank pages of the passport.

Step 6:

Decorate the cover and back of your passport. You can glue the Sprout logo and passport symbol to the front to make it look like the one on TV.



Taa-daaa! You've got a passport!

Step 7:

Just imagine all the places you can go and the many adventures you can have! Take your Passport along with you as you explore the world. Make new pages and draw pictures of the people, places, and things you see.

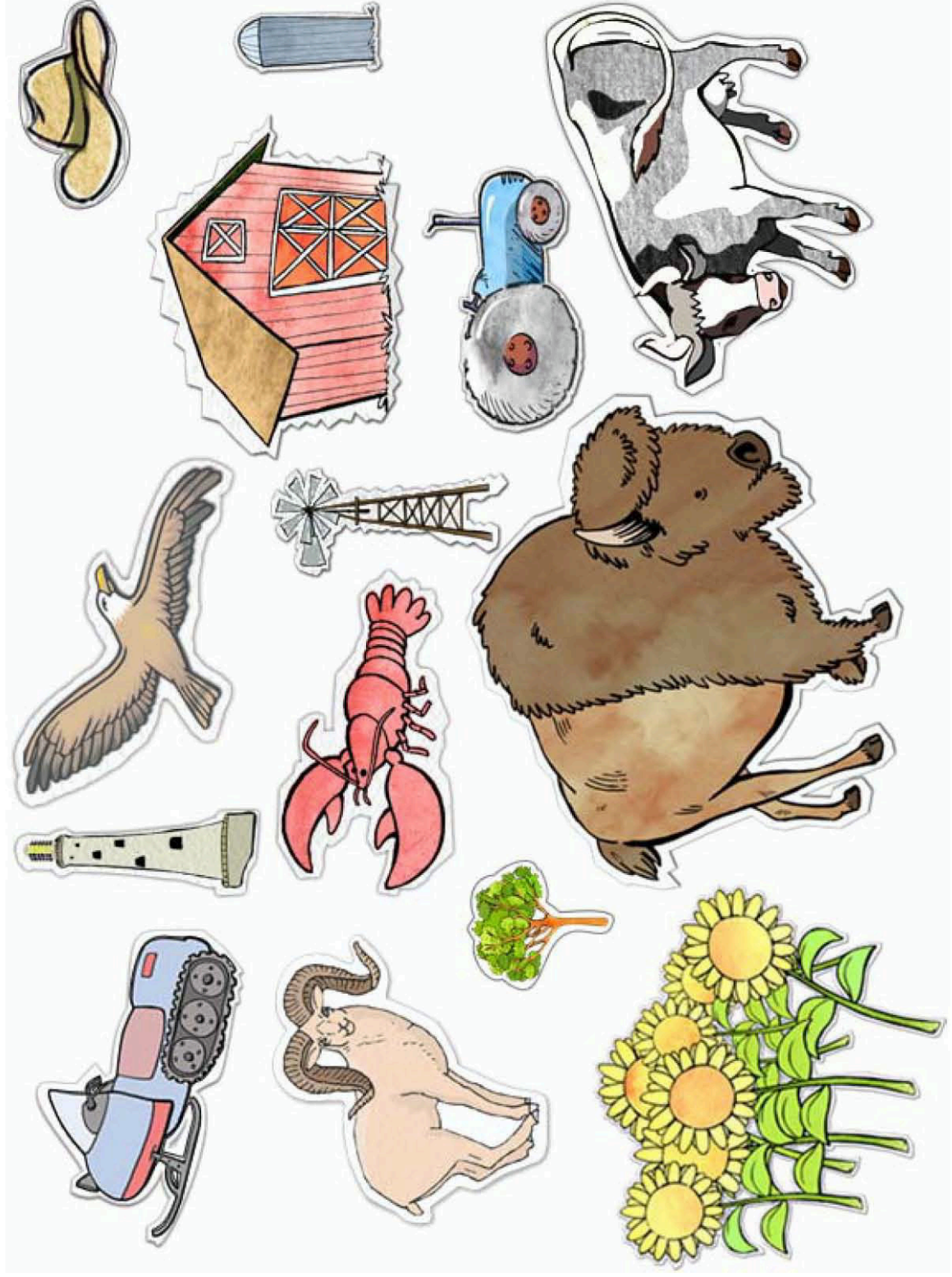

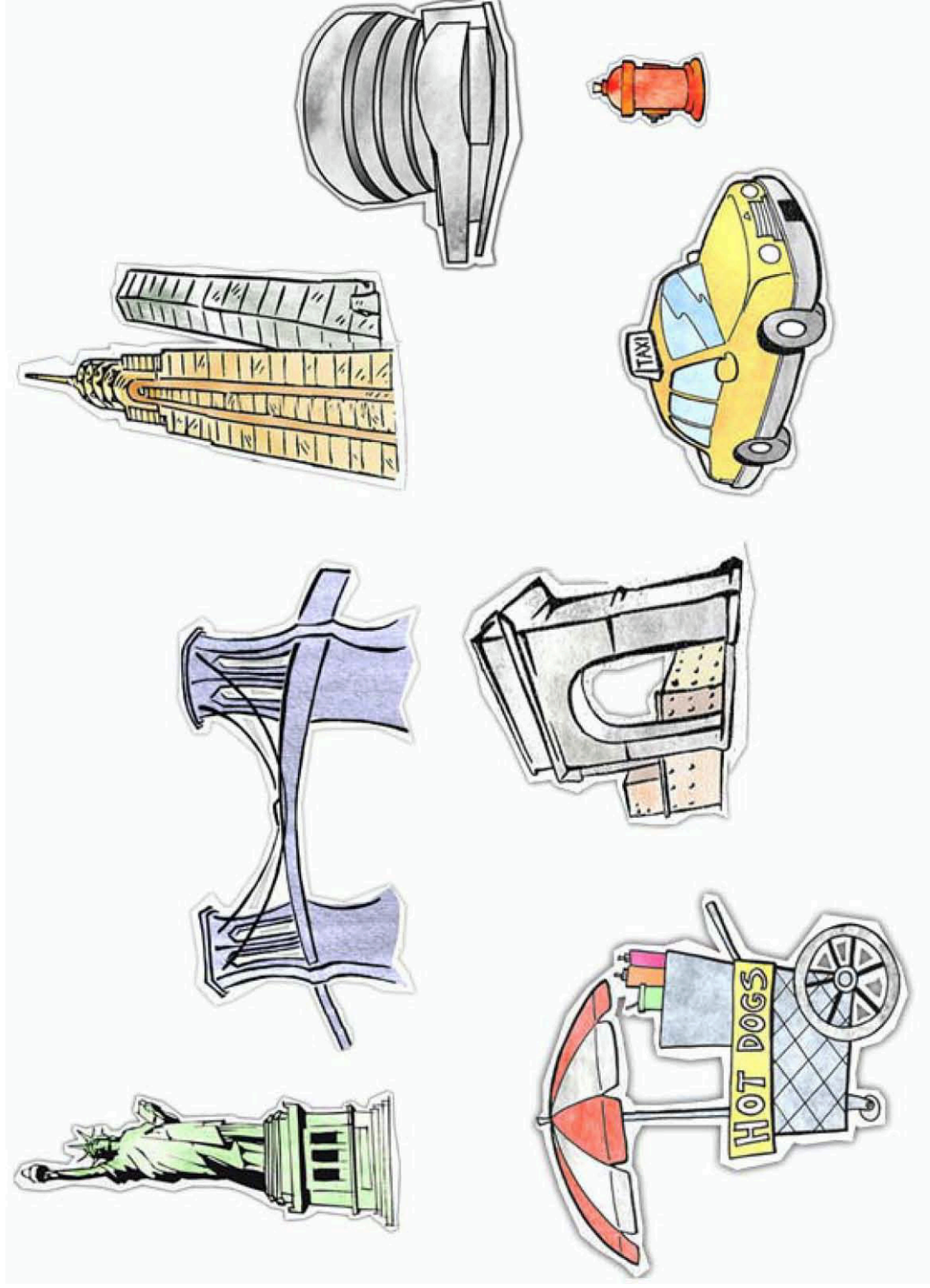
